THIS INDENTURE OF TRUST made on the 21 st day of December, 2005 by

w/o of shri.M.Vijayan aged 38 years. (3) shri.V.Arun s/o Shri.M.Vijayan aged 19 years all
residing at 1/780, Bharathi nagar, Ramanathapuram (hereinafter collectively referred to as THE
AUTHORS.

WHEREAS the Authors are desirous of creating a Charitable Trust of public nature
hereinafter called the " R.K.SAMY EDUCATIONAL TRUST " for the objects set out hereunder
and to be administered under the terms as set out hereunder.

WHEREAS the Authors have also agreed to act as the first Trustees of the said Trust.
NOW this Instrument witnesseth as follows :

The Authors "ave set apart a sum of Rs.10,000 . (Ten Thousand) as a nucleus of the fund for the
said Trust for the objects hereinafter set out.

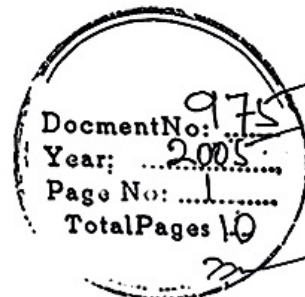

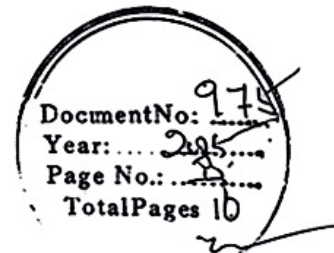
I. The objects of the Trust are the following :

- to Establish, maintain, run, develop, take over, tmprove, and grant donations for educational institutions of all kinds, technical, medtcal, agricultural, general and to promote or aid industrial and other kinds of research for the benefit of the public in general
- To establish, maintain, run, develop, take over, tmprove, and grant donations for institution for the care of the sick, the old and the infirm and orphans such as Hospitals, Nursing Homes: Maternity Homes and all kinds of other Medical Institutions for the public.
- To establish the activity of Socro economic development of Rural Poor. organizing Educational program, skill Training program, Income Generation Activity, Awareness program on various Social Issues but without involving the activity' on of any security for profit.
- To build, erect, and construct and to aid assist in the building, erection and construction of houses, tenements and places of residence for the poor. needy and defectives generally and particularly amongst the labouring classes and to afford them all comforts and conveniences at minimum cost.
- To provide financial assistance foe poor and needy persons or aforesaid loans without interest or at nominal rate of interest for their education, marriage or medical treatment.

- f) To distribute food, cloth, books and other necessities free of cost to the poor and the needy.
- g) To afford medical relief to the sick and suffering irrespective of caste community or breed.
- h) To help, assist and give aid to the parents of other natural guardians or near relations of indigent and unmarried girls for their marriages.
- i) To establish, maintain, run, develop, improve, extend and to aid and assist in the establishment, maintenance, running, development, improvement and extension of libraries, reading rooms, Recreation centres and all other facilities as are calculated to be use in imparting education to the Indian public and particularly to the labouring classes.
- j) To help, aid and assist rural reconstruction work and cottage industries, and poor agriculturists and to do all and carryout other matters incidental thereto, but without involving the carrying on of any activity for profit.
- k) Any other object of general public utility not involving the carrying off any advice like payment and to do all other necessary and incidental things or matters for the purpose of achieving the above objects more effectively.

The income of the Trust shall be applied for charitable purposes in India or accumulated for such purposes in India.

The above objects shall each be independent of the other or others and the funds the Trust may be applied from time to time in carrying out all or any of the aforesaid objects as the Trustees may think fit.

- 2) The Authors of the Trust shall each be a Trustees for his life, unless he vacates office earlier by reason of any of the following contingencies: The
- a) does not desire to continue in office as such Trustee and hence resigns his office in writing; or
 - b) is adjudged insolvent or
 - c) is found to be becoming a person of unsound mind

Whenever any vacancy is caused in the office of the Trustee by death, or by any of the reasons aforesaid, the other Trustees shall appoint the oldest issue of male or female or such Trustees other than a co-opted Trustee and failing such issue the oldest legal descendent male or female who shall continue to hold office of the Trust for his or her life as the case may be or until he or she vacates his or her office of the Trust by death or for any reason mentioned in the clauses herein above.

- 3) IT SHALL open to the Trustees to co- opt one or more additional Trustees. Such additional Trustee or Trustees shall be termed as co- opted Trustees. Such co- opted Trustees shall hold office only for one year from the date of co- option after which period he shall vacate office or can be co-opted again. Such co-opted Trustees shall also

vacate office earlier if he does not desire to continue in the office and send his resignation in writing or if he is adjudged insolvent, or if he is convicted for any offence involving moral turpitude or if he is found to be of unsound mind or if he is found to suffer from any incurable disease or bodily infirmity which renders them unfit for active work or if the Authors of the Trust or their descendents holding office as Trustees unanimously decide that the continuance of the co-opted Trustee will not be conducive to the proper administration of the Trust.

- 4) Shri M. Vijayan shall be the first managing Trustee and shall hold office for 5 years from the date of these presents unless he resigns or retires or otherwise vacates his office earlier. Thereafter the managing Trustee shall be elected for a period of 5 years from among the Trustees other the co-opted Trustees and the retiring. Managing Trustee shall also be eligible for re-elections.
- 5) **THE FUNDS** of the Trust may be invested :
 - a) in any of the securities or authorised by section 20 of the Indian Trust Act, 1882 and in the modes specified under the provisions of 13(1)(d) read with section II of the Income tax act 1961 as amended from time to time;
 - b) in the purchase or acquisition of land or building or leaseholds or in the construction of buildings.
 - c) in current or fixed deposits with or in fully paid shares, with equity, as preference or in debenture stock of or loans to any bank, company or statutory corporation or firm or any other person.
 - d) to employ the funds in such industry, trade, agriculture, business or businesses as may be determined by the Trustees and to carry on such industry, trade, agriculture, business or businesses the industry trade, business or businesses with all their assets, profits and loss belonging to the Trust.
- 6) **ALL THE PROPERTIES** of the Trust shall stand in the name of the Trust.

POWER OF TRUSTEES

- 7) **ALL THE TRUSTEES** who for that time and from time to time are in office, with the retired to collectively as the Board and the Trust shall be managed by the Board of Trustees as hereinafter provided and subject to the control and direction of the Board of Trustees.
- 8) IF IN THE opinion of the Board, any property belonging to the Trust is deteriorating its value or is not yielding a reasonable income or that the sale or conversion into property of any other kind would be advantageous to the Trust. The board may exchange the same for property of another kind or sell the property and invest the proceeds in the manner herein before provided.

- 9) THE BOARD SHALL have power to accept contributions in money or property either by way of additions to the Trust funds generally or for any one or more of the specified objects of the Trust in so far as they are not inconsistent with any of provisions of this Trust and in either case such contributions shall be dealt either as capital or as income accounting to the directions of the donors, but subject always to the beneficial administration of the Trust.
- 10) THE BOARD SHALL have power to sell in and convert into cash the Trust properties and realize any or all of the securities and investments and to re- invest them in such manner as they deem fit from time to time in such securities as are authorized by those present.
- 11) THE BOARD SHALL have full power of management to the Trust properties and funds, and they shall have full control over the finances of the Trust. They shall like wise have full powers of supervision over the charitable institutions, schools colleges, hospitals and all the establishments falling within the objects of the Trust that all the establishments falling within the objects of the Trust that may be maintained and conducted in terms of the Trust created hereby.
- 12) THE DAY-TO-DAY and routine administration, applications, direction and management of the Trust and the several institutions and establishments in terms of the Trust hereby created shall be in the Managing Trustee, subject to the control and supervision by the Board of Trustees.
- 13) THE BOARD SHALL is entitled to take all the steps that may be reasonably necessary of required for the preservation of the Trust, in the Trust properties and of the title of the Trust to the Trust properties.
- 14) THE MANAGING TRUSTEE shall arrange for the maintenance of correct and proper accounts of the receipts and payments and for an audit every year of the accounts of the Trust and the income and expenditure relating thereto and the Board shall appoint a Chartered Accountant for this purpose.
- 15) THE TRUSTEES are entitled to utilize the corpus and income arising there from but the purpose of the Trust.
- 16) WHENEVER FOR THE administration of the Trust hereby created or for the establishment, development and conduct of the several institutions maintained hereunder, grants-in-aid from Government are applied for and obtained and it becomes necessary for the due performance of the conditions of such grant to secure the same by a mortgage or charge on the properties of the Trust, the Board shall give power to create such mortgages or charges on all or any of the Trust properties to facilitate the obtaining of such grants, for purchase of lands, for erection of buildings and generally for administration, conduct and maintenance of such institutions.

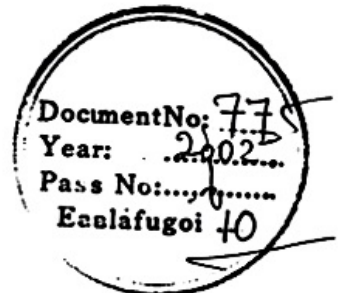

- 17) THE MANAGING TRUSTEE SHALL have power and authority to execute such documents as is necessary for effectively carrying out all or any of the purposes of the Trust.
- 18) THE TRUSTEES shall meet periodically at least once in three months to consider the affairs of the Trust. Such meetings shall be convened by the Managing Trustee by giving due notice to the other Trustees at least ten days before the date of the meeting specifying the time and place of the meeting.
- 19) THE ACCOUNTS of the Trust shall be closed every year on 31st March. The statement of account as on 31st March , every year shall be placed before the Trustees at an annual meeting to be convened for the purpose.
- 20) THE MANAGING TRUSTEE shall be the executive officer of the Board and as such be shall have and be responsible for the custody of records and properties of the Trust and be shall have power and authority for and on behalf of the Board.
- a) To open and close accounts with any bank or banks;
 - b) To carry out the resolutions of the Board ;
 - c) To sign papers; receipts and documents ;
 - d) To receive and pay out money ;
 - e) To draw, endorse and accept and negotiate cheques and bills.
 - f) To draw, endorse and accept and negotiate promissory notes, Hundies or other negotiable instruments, Government or other Securities, papers or bonds and shares, Stocks and debentures and other property of the company ;
 - g) To lease out for a period not exceeding three years, lands and properties of the Trust which are ordinarily leased out ;
 - h) To initiate, prosecute and defend, compromise, refer- to arbitration or abandon legal proceedings or disputes ;
 - i) To borrow from time to time for such period on such terms and conditions and with or without security as the Managing Trustee may determine and to execute such documents and papers as may be necessary in connection therewith ;
 - j) To execute all documents on behalf of the Board.
- 21) THE MANAGING TRUSTEE and the other Trustees may reimburse themselves on pay or disburse out of the Trust Fund moneys in his or their hands all expenses properly incurred by him or them in or about the execution of the Trust and in discharge of the duties imposed on him or them under this Trust. In particular, the Trustees shall have power to draw travelling and other allowances for the purpose of attendance at the meetings of the Board of Trustees and for any other journey undertaken for and on behalf of the Trust.

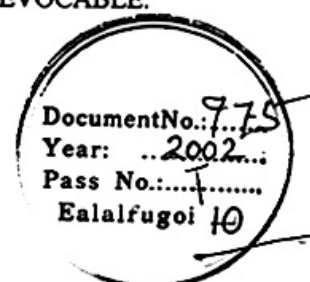


- 22) **THE MANAGING TRUSTEE** on his own motion may, or by a requisition signed by any of the Trustees shall call a meeting of the Board. Such requisition should state specifically the purpose for which the meeting is called for and the Managing Trustee shall call the meeting within a fortnight thereafter.
- 23) **THE QUORUM FOR** meeting of the Trustees shall be two. The Managing Trustee, if present shall preside at the meetings of the Board and in his absence, a chairman shall be elected from among the Trustees present, In all matters not expressly otherwise provided for the decision of the majority of the members present shall be the decision of the Board and shall be binding on all the members of the Board, In the event of the votes being equally divided, The chairman shall have a casting vote in addition to his vote as a member of the Board.
- 24) **NO ACT OR** proceedings of the Board shall be invalid merely by reason of there being one or more vacancies in the Board.
- 25) **NO ACT OR** proceedings of the Board of the Managing Trustee or of any members of the Board shall be deemed to be invalid by reason only of the defect in the appointment or constitution of the Board or of any member thereof or on the ground that any member of the Board was not entitled to hold or continue in office by reason of any disqualification or by reason of such act having been done or proceedings taken during the period of any vacancy in the office of the Managing Trustee or any other Trustee.
- 26) **THE TRUSTEES SHALL** have power to incur all reasonable and proper expenditure for the maintenance of any establishment for and in connection with the affairs of the Trust.
- 27) **THE TRUSTEES SHALL** conform to the provisions of the Indian Trust act in all matters expressly provided for herein.
- 28) **THE BOARD ARE** hereby authorized to and they may from time to time make and prescribe rules, in addition to or in substitution make and prescribe rules in addition to or in substitution of the rules and regulation hereoff contained for more effectively regulating their carrying out of the objects of the Trust, investment of the Trust Funds and realization thereof and all other matters incidental to the working of the Trusts and from time to time modify alter or amend such bylaws and rules provided that no such bylaws or rules shall in any way alter or contravene the objects of the Trust.
- 29) **IF AT ANY** time the objects of the Trust should become impossible of fulfilment the properties and lands belonging to the Trust shall be utilized for such other allied charitable and or education purposes as the Board for the time being may determine.
- 30) **IF IS EXPRESSLY** declared that the Trust created hereby is IRREVOCABLE.

- 31) No amendments to the Memorandum of Association and rules and regulations shall be made. Which may prove repugnant to the provisions of section 21(5), 11 to 13 and 80 G of the Income Tax Act 1961 as amended from time to time, the amendments shall be carried out without the prior approval of the Commissioner of Income-Tax.
- 32) In the event of dissolution or winding up of the Trust, the assets remaining as on that date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees / Members of the Managing Committee or Members of the Governing Body, but the same shall be transferred to another charitable Trust whose objects are similar to those of this Trust and which enjoy recognition under section 80 G of the Income Tax Act 1961.

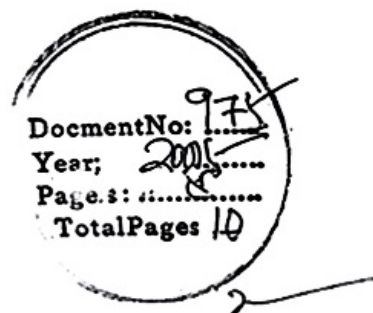
